*There is a voluntary admission fee for spectators (not volunteers or participants). It is \$.50 student, \$1 adult, or \$2 family. Spectators enter through door 15. It will be donated to charity. In addition, concessions will be sold in the cafetorium throughout the evening.

- **4:30pm** Report to school (door 9) in black dress pants, black socks, black dress shoes, and a PLAIN WHITE t-shirt or tank top. You can stay after school if you would like be sure you bring your uniform articles with you.
- **4:30pm-5pm** Change into uniform in LIBRARY. Bring all instruments and music in the library. PERCUSSION: all needed mallets, beaters, accessories need to be moved from the band room to the library during this time as well.
- **5pm-5:15pm** Check in with your assigned chaperone. NO EATING BEFORE OUR PERFORMANCE.
- **5:15PM** Get out instruments and gather music. DO NOT PLAY INSTRUMENTS IN THE LIBRARY. Pep talk from Mrs. Lake-Becker.
- **5:28pm** Move AS A GROUP to the band room for our warm-up and tuning. There will not be percussion equipment available here. Percussionists should make sure they have all needed materials from the library with them at this point.
- **5:45pm** <u>ARBOR PARK PERFORMANCE IN THE GYM</u>. We will go directly to the SMALL gym at the conclusion of our performance for our yearbook picture.
- **6:10pm** Report back to library put away instruments, equipment and report to your chaperone. All students are to stay with their assigned chaperone the rest of the evening. You will have time to eat with your group when your chaperone decides. All students are with their chaperone in the cafeteria or in the gym listening to other bands the entire evening. Sit in the area labeled for Arbor Park in the gym. Each school has an area.
- **7:10pm** All-Star Band members should report to the library to get their instruments/music and report to the small gym for rehearsal. Sit in your same seat from the All-Star rehearsal.
- **7:30pm** ALL ARBOR STUDENTS REPORT TO THE GYM and sit in the section labeled for our school. We will be listening to the last band (Worth) and then the All-Star Band.
- **7:50ish pm** CONCLUSION of the ALL-STAR PERFORMANCE All Arbor students have stations with their chaperone for clean-up. Report there immediately after the All-Star band is done. The quicker you complete your task, the quicker we get to leave.

Main Gym and Small Gym – All-Star Band will pack away Hille and Arbor percussion equipment/stands and check the small gym for any stands or equipment to be put away. **(O'LEARY)**

Choir Room and Band Room – Trumpets/Baritones/Percussion will re-set chairs in both rooms and put stands on the racks neatly. **(REZACK)**

Signs – Flutes and Clarinets will remove and collect all signs from homerooms, hallways, and the bleachers in the gym. **(MONTOYA)**

Cafeteria/Main Gym – Saxophones will help clean-up the cafeteria and then assist in the main gym to rack the stands. **(BARTECKI)**

Once your clean-up station is completed, report to the library with your chaperone to change out of your uniform. All uniforms need to be hung up NEATLY AND IN THE CORRECT AREA OF THE RACK.

8:30pm - APPROXIMATE dismissal after clean-up.
